CURRICULUM

Our curriculum is broad and balanced and can be categorised into 11 subject frameworks - Art, Computing, Design & Technology, English, Geography, History, Maths, Music, PHSE, RE and Science. Our curriculum design is sequenced and underpinned by reading, as research shows that reading is the foundation stone of knowledge. Following this, pupils then have the knowledge and skills to write to at greater depth and have greater comprehension of their texts.

Our school is over 150 years old and still has many of its original features, providing warmth and character to our main classrooms. We have our own playing field, a newly built Woodland Hall, where assemblies take place, lunches are served and indoor PE takes place. Our purpose built EYFS building, enables our younger children to settle into school life easily and calmly, plus we have a woodland trail ready for Forest School, bug hunting and adventure!

COMMUNITY

The school is well supported by its local community. Friends of South Kilworth run a variety of events in order to raise funds for the school and our governors volunteer to support the school in its continued development. We work with local organisations to enrich our curriculum and allow our children to try their hands at new (and sometimes traditional) activities - from Crown Bowls to meeting inspiring F1 engineers. We have strong links with St Nicholas' South Kilworth Church, meaning we take part in services and have regular visits from their team.



WIDER CURRICULUM OPPORTUNITIES

We provide after school sports clubs, a gardening club and always welcome volunteers to help us establish new opportunities for our children. All children leave us being able to swim, with targeted swimming lessons held in the Autumn term. We also have a full calendar of trips, residential stays, Forest School and school performances.

HOT SCHOOL MEALS

Hot school meals are provided daily from our sister school, Lubenham All Saints CE Primary School. Two hot meal choices plus a cold sandwich option are available every day. Free school meals are offered to all children in Foundation Stage and Years 1 and 2 under the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals programme. Children can also bring packed lunches from home.
